WHEREAS, Ms. Moynihan has been elected to the Connecticut House of Representatives, thus necessitating her resignation from the Board of Trustees, therefore be it

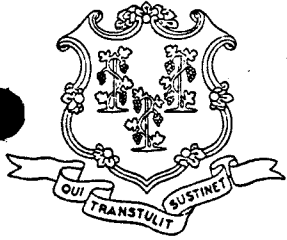
