RESOLVED, That, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, the increased Tuition Fund spending plan be financed by drawing down the fund balance and by increasing, effective July 1, 1991, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students as follows:
