WHEREAS, The Honorable T. Clark Hull has served the people of the State of Connecticut as a legislator, Lieutenant Governor, Judge and Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, and

WHEREAS, He received an undergraduate degree from Yale University and a law degree from Harvard University and distinguished himself as a practicing attorney in Danbury, Connecticut for 25 years, and

WHEREAS, He has devoted himself to countless civic activities including the Board of Danbury Hospital, where he served for 22 years, and

WHEREAS, He has championed various legal reforms, including the revision of the state penal code and the review of legal ethics and attorney grievance procedures, and

WHEREAS, He is recognized as a dedicated legal scholar, and warm and personable human being, and has agreed to share his vast knowledge and experience with the students at Western Connecticut State University, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Connecticut State University Board of Trustees grant T. Clark Hull the title, Scholar-in-Residence, for the 1991-92 academic year at Western Connecticut State University and extend to him all the rights and privileges of such title.
