TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

July 19, 1991


WHEREAS, Tuition revenue projections using current rates will not be sufficient to support the 1992-93 projected operating budget of the Connecticut State University, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #91-8 is repealed, and be it

RESOLVED, That the 1992-93 Tuition Fund spending plan be financed by drawing down the fund balance and by increasing, effective July 1, 1992, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students as follows;
