

## RESOLUTION

## concerning

AN INCREASE IN THE STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT FEE FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS

December 6, 1991

WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover the long range facilities program for self-liquidating obligations, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #90-174 is hereby rescinded, and be it

RESOLVED, That the State University Student Fee rates be increased from \$220 to \$270 per semester (\$540 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut, and from \$541 to \$664 per semester (\$1,328 per academic year) for nonresidents, to be effective with the Fall semester of 1992.
