

December 6, 1991

- WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and
- WHEREAS, Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover escalating costs due to inflation and salary adjustments, be it
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #90-176 is rescinded, and be it
- RESOLVED, That effective with the Fall Semester 1992, the charges per academic year per participating student for providing food services shall be changed as shown in the addendum to this resolution.
