- WHEREAS, The current F. R. Noble Laboratory School at Eastern Connecticut State University is being renovated into a modern, residence hall facility, and
- WHEREAS, Such facility will be open to students at the beginning of the Fall Semester, 1992, and
- WHEREAS, F. R. Noble served as Principal of Willimantic State Normal School from 1918 to 1937 and first President of Willimantic State Teachers College from 1937 to 1947, and
- WHEREAS, Dr. David G. Carter, President of Eastern Connecticut State University, has recommended that F. R. Noble continue to be the namesake for the building, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That effective this date, the F. R. Noble Laboratory School at Eastern Connecticut State University be hereby renamed the F. R. Noble Residence Hall.
