FEE INCREASES FOR CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENTS TIER II

WHEREAS,	Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of
	Trustees for the Connecticut State University shall fix fees for
	such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, An exercise facility has been in operation for a number of years at Southern Connecticut State University and is available to dormitory/apartment residents and students residing off campus, and

WHEREAS, The administration at Southern Connecticut State University has requested a \$5 per semester increase for on-campus students and \$10 increase for off-campus students to allow for the repair and maintenance of the exercise equipment, and

WHEREAS, Central Connecticut State University prepares music majors and provides instruction to individual students, and

WHEREAS, The administration at Central Connecticut State University has requested an increase in the Applied Music Fee to \$150 per semester for an Undergraduate 1/2 hour lesson and \$200 per semester for a Graduate 1/2 hour lesson to defray increased personnel costs for instruction, and

WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State University has requested authorization to establish a plan which would permit students to pay tuition and fees over the course of a year, and

WHEREAS, This plan replaces an outside firm which provided a similar service for students at a cost of \$45 per participating student although significant administrative support is provided by Southern Connecticut State University, and

WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State University can administer such a plan more cost-effectively, and

WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State University is requesting a \$50 Payment Plan Fee to cover the costs of personnel, supplies, mail and computer software to administer the plan, therefore be it



RESOLVED, That Board Resolution 87-187 (Nautilus Fee) be rescinded, and be it further

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution 86-160 "Increase in Applied Music" is amended, and be it further

RESOLVED, That effective for the Fall 1993 semester the fee requests indicated above and reflected in the attached fee schedule be approved.
