We have been given an ion implanter by the National Semiconductor Corporation in Danbury, Serial Number 0301450-69028-34561-34086. The value of the equipment exceeds \$10,000, and will require Board of Trustees approval before we can actually take possession.

The equipment has been certified as being clean by the State of Connecticut Department of Health Services, Bureau of Laboratories, and the chiller will be converted to a closed-circuit device, which will conserve water and will not imbalance the New Britain water system.
