MICROCOMPUTER PROCUREMENT

December 2, 1994

WHEREAS, Our universities and the system office have purchased a significant number of microcomputers which requires that faculty and staff be trained in their use to ensure their effective utilization, and

WHEREAS, The universities perform much of the maintenance associated with these computers in-house, and

WHEREAS, The purchase of an extensive variety of these computers would increase significantly the cost of training, maintenance, licensing, user support and other related costs, and

WHEREAS, The marketplace for microcomputers has changed dramatically from both a technological and price perspective and in order to take advantage of these improvements, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board resolutions shown below be rescinded:

87-85 a resolution concerning microcomputer procurement by Connecticut State University

93-4 a resolution concerning microcomputer procurement,

and be it further

RESOLVED, That microcomputer purchases within the Connecticut State University system be standardized on the following brands: Apple, Compaq, DEC, Gateway, IBM, Tandy, and Zenith.
