RESOLUTION

concerning

AMENDMENT OF STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES GUIDELINES IN THE AREA OF COMPUTER OFFENSES

October 6, 1995

WHEREAS, Increased student use of university computer systems and networks reflects a highly positive educational development within the CSU System but simultaneously necessitates an up-dating of existing computer "offenses" in the Student Rights and Responsibilities document, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Item 25 in the uniform list of Proscribed Conduct in the Appendix of Punishable Offenses and Maximum Sanctions of the Guidelines for Student Rights and Responsibilities and Judicial Procedures is hereby repealed and the following is adopted:

25. Unauthorized use of University computers and/or peripheral systems and networks; unauthorized access to University computer programs or files; unauthorized alteration or duplication of University computer programs or files; any deliberate action to disrupt the operation of University computer systems which serve other members of the University community, including all networks to which University computers are connected; use of University computer systems and networks for committing crimes, violating civil laws, or violating University rules.
