RESOLUTION

concerning

THE ACCEPTANCE OF PROPERTY FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

February 16, 1996

- WHEREAS, The Connecticut State University system owns property in Newington commonly known as "The Marshall Property", and
- WHEREAS, The University wishes to have an access road to the Newington property, and
- WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation is willing to give the Connecticut State University system a parcel of land of approximately 3.9 acres of land which would provide such an access, and
- WHEREAS, The biology department at Central Connecticut State University would like to use this site to plant and study various species of trees which are native to Connecticut, and
- WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation is willing to grant a Right of Entry through a railway right of way adjacent to Lester Street in New Britain running beneath Route 9 which will provide access to this parcel and the "Marshall Property", therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University system accept the transfer of approximately 3.9 acres of land from the Department of Transportation.
