## RESOLUTION

## ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TITLE

## CHANCELLOR of the CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM

June 14, 1996

- WHEREAS, The President of the Connecticut State University System is the chief executive officer for the CSU System, and
- WHEREAS, The title of "President" has led to confusion between the System President and the Presidents of Central, Eastern, Southern and Western Connecticut State Universities, and
- WHEREAS, Nationally, most systems of higher education designate their chief executive officer as "Chancellor," therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution 83-160 establishing the title of President is hereby repealed, and be it
- RESOLVED, That the title President of the Connecticut State University System be changed to Chancellor of the Connecticut State University System, and that in the policy statements of the Trustees which are currently in effect and in all other documents that are currently in effect, where the term "President" appears it shall have the same meaning as Chancellor, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the current President, Dr. William J. Cibes, Jr., be and hereby is named Chancellor of the Connecticut State University System with no change in responsibilities, duties, or salary.
