## ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS

## November 1, 1996

- WHEREAS, The Connecticut State University System has always recognized the value of the co-curricula and/or extra-curricula experiences such as those available on the CSU campuses, and
- WHEREAS, Historically part-time students were not afforded the opportunity to participate in the student activities, organizations, and/or the non-intercollegiate athletic clubs, programs and events, and
- WHEREAS, The participation in student activities, organizations and/or the non-intercollegiate athletic clubs and events should require the coverage of accident insurance for any participating student (full-time or part-time), and
- WHEREAS, The Connecticut State University System has provided optional combined accident and sickness insurance for part-time students since April 3, 1992 under BR #92-41, which may be used as the required coverage for part-time students who wish to participation in student activities, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the following rules shall govern part-time student participating in student activities, organizations and/or the non-intercollegiate athletic clubs and events:
  - A. The students must be matriculated and enrolled in courses for credit at the time and during the semester and at the CSU campus where the student chooses to participate in student activities, student organizations and/or the non-intercollegiate clubs and events.
  - B. It is mandatory that students who elect to participate in student activities must purchase the accident insurance made available at CSU, or the existing accident/sickness insurance.
  - C. The accident insurance is not mandatory for those part-time students who choose not to participate in student activities;

and be it further

RESOLVED, That the accident insurance program shall allow students to purchase the accident insurance program for periods of six months (January through June or July through December), or the annual policy for twelve months.
