- WHEREAS, A systematic review of low enrollment degree programs was conducted at the Connecticut State University System during 1995-96 as requested by the Commissioner of the Department of Higher Education, now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System approves elimination of the following degree programs at Central Connecticut State University to the Board of Governors for Higher Education. The appropriate University review procedures have been completed and the President of Central Connecticut State University has certified that all currently enrolled students have had appropriate opportunity to graduate.
