WHEREAS, A systematic review of low enrollment degree programs was conducted at the Connecticut State University System during 1995-96 as requested by the Commissioner of the Department of Higher Education, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System approves the elimination of the Master of Business Administration (MBA) Specialization in Management Degree Program (520201) at Western Connecticut State University to the Board of Governors for Higher Education. The appropriate University review procedures have been completed and the President of Western Connecticut State University has certified that all currently enrolled students have had appropriate opportunity to graduate.
