This gift of \$10,000 from Pfizer, Inc. will be used to support Central's biochemistry course program and has been deposited in the University's operating fund.

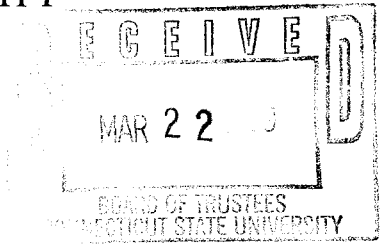
